

Rules for the All Oregon Holstein Show

1. The one making the entry shall be the exhibitor. Junior Ownership must be designated. All livestock eligible for competition must be accompanied by a Certificate of Registration with a minimum of 87% RHA, including all calves and ET animals, and it shall be the duty of the Chairman, to reject all animals not complying with these conditions. Proof of ownership on term animals must be accompanied in the form of a registration paper.
2. Entries for the All Oregon Show are open only to exhibitors who are members of the Oregon Holstein Assn. Entries also are open only to the Oregon residents whose dairy operation is based in Oregon. Entries for the All Oregon and Jr. All Oregon Show must be made on the official blanks furnished and be in the hands of the Secretary by 6-15-19 accompanied with a **\$20.00 per head entry fee**. A printed program will be furnished, any substitution must be made by 8:00 p.m., 6-27-19. Substitutions must be accompanied with a Certificate of Registration. Entries received after 6-15-19 will be charged an additional \$5.00 late entry fee per animal(s). Junior Exhibitors will not be charged a late fee.
3. All production records must accompany entries and will be printed in the program to be eligible for awards. Production records must be recognized after classes are judged. To qualify for awards the records must be completed within the last calendar year. ME records are not acceptable and will not be printed EXCEPT on the 2 Year Olds which projected 305D records are acceptable. All records will be converted to 2x 3.5% FAT corrected milk. Winner must place in the top half of the class to qualify for overall production award.
4. The ring chairman reserves the right to interpret all the rules for the best interest of the show. No exhibitor will be entitled to more than two ribbons in any one class. Group classes No. 10 (Jr. Best 3), Class No. 25 (Senior best 3) and Class No. 26 (Exhibitor Herd) are limited to one entry per exhibitor.
5. Sale of milk is necessary to generate revenue for our show. Anyone violating antibiotic regulations will pay the damage. SNAP tests will be done on a random basis.
6. Breeders are individually responsible for the safety and welfare of his or her own cattle from any loss or damage that the exhibitor might cause.
7. **No show animals are to arrive at the fairgrounds before noon on Wednesday, June 26th.**
8. Sawdust, and grain will be furnished. Straw will be available for bedding only- NOT to be used for end bales (If exhibitors would like end bales for their ally ways they must be supplied by exhibitor). Hay can be purchased at the Tillamook Feed Store.
9. **No garbage or paper towels are to be thrown in the straw/manure. The board may assess a penalty for exhibitors not following this rule.**
10. **No vehicles or feed bales will be allowed in the fairgrounds courtyard area.**
12. Ribbons for All Oregon will be through three places; Junior All Oregon Holstein Show will be through 5 places. Premier Breeder and Exhibitor points will be based on the top 6 animals with the maximum of 4 milking cows as follows: Milking Cows: 20-17-14-10-8-6; Heifers: 12-10-8-7-6-5. Lease animals are not eligible for the Exhibitor points. **Exhibitor points will follow the National Show Ring rules.** All 1st place winners will be designated All Oregon and will be photographed at the owner's expense. Multiple animal ownership: the person showing the animal must enter and house the animal with his entries to be eligible for the points for the group classes. *No exhibitor or breeder points awarded fur futurity placings.*
- 12A. **Animals purchased at the Main Event Sale are eligible to show at the ALL OR SHOW by Oregon exhibitors only. \$20. Per head entry fee is required.**

JUNIOR EXHIBITOR INFORMATION:

11. All Juniors to be eligible to show in Conformation and showmanship must provide proof of ownership in the form of a minimum of 87% RHA or a 4-H Lease. Agreement which must be in force

before June 1st, 2019. One (1) lease animal and her progeny per exhibitor. Ownership animals and 4-H lease animals must be shown by the Junior to qualify for the Jr. All Oregon & Champion Jr. & Sr. Exhibitor Award. To qualify for junior awards, a junior member that is in the Intermediate or Senior age divisions (ages 12-21) must show their own animal without the assistance of an adult. If assistance is needed, an older junior member may help. Children ages 11 and under may still have the help of an adult if needed when showing. **All Junior exhibitors MUST participate in showmanship on Friday, June 28th to be eligible to participate in the junior conformation show on Saturday.** All 1st place calves and yearlings to compete for the Jr. Champion Exhibitor. All cows milking and dry to compete for the Champion Sr. Award. The All Oregon Holstein Show will be designated Junior All Oregon. The National Junior Showring Policy will be enforced. Juniors winning more than 1 class may obtain help of a Junior to show in the Championship classes. NOTE: Junior Exhibitors may show lease animal and her progeny if they do not own an animal at the show. Any animal purchased by a Jr. at the sale is eligible to show in the All OR Show and will be eligible for the Jr. Awards if owner participated in showmanship on Friday.

A Junior Showmanship contest will start on Friday, 6-28-18 at 10:00 a.m. with the Senior Class followed by Intermediates, junior and novice classes. Ages for the classes will be as of 1-1-19: Novice to 8 years, Junior 9-11, Intermediate 12-14 and Senior 15-21. Sign up sheet will be provided.

14. The Champion Junior and Senior Exhibitor winner will be photographed at no cost. All other Junior winners can be photographed at their expense
